Program Requirements for Participants:

- ♣ Successfully completed 11th grade
- ♣ Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75
- ♣ Successful completion of Algebra II and Biology
- ♣ With a grades of a "B" or higher in all science and mathematics courses
- ♣ Must reside in Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Middlesex, Passaic or Union county
- Must meet Federal Trio Low-Income Levels (see below)
- Must be a potential first-generation college student.
